



<p>Operating an impact driver</p> 	<p>Lacerations Punctures Slips Trips Falls</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Don PPE, including safety glasses, work boots and gloves. • Wear hearing protection when ambient noise from other machinery or from continuous “ratcheting” of the driver creates high decibel levels. • A dust mask should also be worn if you are working around wood or saw dust. • Avoid loose clothing or jewelry that can get caught in machinery. Keep long hair away from moving parts. • Hold power tool by insulated gripping surfaces, when performing an operation where the fastener may contact hidden wiring. • Do not hold bit while the impact driver is in motion, hands can get caught. • Continuous use of the driver can cause vibration. Additionally drivers will “ratchet” when tightening and cause vibration. Make sure to take short breaks at frequent intervals to rest hands. • Work directly in front of you; avoid over-reaching as this can create slips and falls.
