Wear a dust mask if dust or metal shards are generated. • Wear hearing protection when noise is present, such as working in a shop or on a construction site. • Dress properly. Do not wear loose clothing, jewelry. • Ensure work area is kept clean and well lit to avoid accidental trips and falls. • Keep hair, clothes and gloves away from moving parts. • Never use tool if cord is frayed or plug is damaged. • To avoid accidental starting ensure hand is not on trigger when plugging the device in. • Avoid overreaching by keeping proper footing and balance. • Do not force the blade as it can bend and dislodge or break. • Avoid operating tool for long periods of time as vibration can occur. • Always disconnect the device before making any adjustments or changing blades. • Only use accessories and blades are designed for the device, do not force blades that do not fit. |
